The Economy and Housing

 Harris emphasized more housing units must be built at a lower cost to consumers. Harris said her administration would work with the private sector and homebuilders to build 3 million homes by the end of her first term. She also highlighted her plan to provide \$25,000 in assistance to first-time homebuyers.

Harris

- Harris said Trump oversaw the highest unemployment rate following the COVID-19 pandemic and that numerous sources found Trump's economic policies would be inflationary.
- Harris stated she has a plan to build an "opportunity economy" that invests in small businesses and families to bring down the cost of living.

 Trump said the level of inflation under the Biden-Harris administration is unprecedented and that it puts pressure on the middle class by raising the cost of essential goods. He also criticized the Biden administration for failing to remove

economic advisors who failed to tame inflation.

- Trump said he oversaw a strong economy, and the pandemic derailed economic growth during his presidency. Trump also highlighted the stock market gains achieved during his presidency.
- Trump claimed that the job gains under the Biden administration were caused by a natural bounce back following the COVID-19 pandemic.

Health Care

 Harris criticized Trump for leaving the country in the "worst public health epidemic in a century" due to his mismanagement of the pandemic. She said Trump thanked Chinese leader Xi Jinping, whom she argued failed to be transparent about the origins of COVID-19.

- Harris expressed strong support for reinstating Roe v. Wade
 protections and emphasized her commitment to signing these
 protections into law. After Roe v. Wade was overturned, Harris
 labeled state-level abortion restrictions as "Trump abortion
 bans," holding him responsible for appointing Supreme Court
 justices who undermined reproductive freedoms. Harris
 condemned the fact that women across the country are being
 denied care or having to travel across state lines to seek
 abortion care.
- Harris advocated for strengthening the Affordable Care Act (ACA), highlighting the Biden administration's success in lowering prescription drug costs through Medicare negotiations

 Trump highlighted his administration's actions during the COVID-19 pandemic, such as providing ventilators for other countries and distributing gowns and masks. He added that his administration does not get enough credit for its COVID-19 strategy and efforts.

- Trump noted that he strongly believes in exceptions for abortion in the cases of rape, incest and the life of the mother. He added that abortion is now back in the hands of the states and the votes of the people instead of being tied up in the federal government. Trump reiterated he would not need to sign a national abortion ban because the decision is up to the states. He said he also continues to be a leader on in-vitro fertilization.
- Trump said ACA coverage is too expensive for the population.
 He noted that he is looking at alternatives and has concepts of
 a plan that he will try to replace the ACA with if it costs less
 money and has better quality of care. He said during his

Immigration

 Harris noted her prior support of the Emergency National Security Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2024 (H.R.815), also known as the bipartisan Senate border security bill, stating that the package would have: (1) provided for an additional 50,000 border officials; (2) empowered border authorities to stem the flow of fentanyl into the country; and (3) provided additional resources toward the prosecution of transnational criminal organizations.

 Harris stated that Trump caused the demise of the Senate's bipartisan border security bill because he wanted to campaign on the issue of immigration rather than seeing the problem get addressed. • Trump claimed that Haitian immigrants are eating cats and dogs in Springfield, Ohio.

Trump

- Trump claimed undocumented immigrants are violently entering the United States, and that they have taken control of several towns across the country.
- Trump assailed the Biden administration for permitting millions of undocumented immigrants to enter the country, including ones who are criminals, terrorists or drug dealers.
- Trump declared that undocumented immigrants are "destroying the fabric of our country."
- Trump stated that migrant crime is occurring "at levels that nobody thought possible" and that undocumented immigrants with criminal histories have come from across the globe to enter the United States. He continued by claiming that crime rates in other countries have decreased because those individuals have since emigrated to the United States.
- Trump questioned why Harris was not taking steps to address the millions of people entering the country via the U.S.-Mexico border. He subsequently called on Harris to sign a bill that would close the border, adding that if Biden called for the border to be closed, border officials would immediately comply with doing so.
- Trump declared that the United States must construct walls and establish strong borders in order for the nation to be secured.

- Trump claimed Democrats are allowing undocumented immigrants to enter the country as a means to get them to become registered voters who would support their candidates.
- Trump alleged that Harris served as the Biden administration's "border czar," adding that Harris did not want to be labeled as such "because she's embarrassed by the border."

Defense and Competition with China

Harris Trum

- Harris said the Trump administration sold American technologies to benefit Chinese technological advancement and military modernization.
- Harris said America should focus on winning the competition with China through investing in the American economy, domestic technologies and international partnerships.
- Harris said Trump was not firm in opposition to dictators, including Putin, Xi and Kim Jong Un, and he praised Russia's invasion of Ukraine.
- Harris said Ukraine still stands because of the aid the United States and its allies have contributed to its defense. She said America should invest in its alliances and collectively oppose adversaries.

- Trump disagreed that he sold the U.S. computer chip industry to China, and he said China purchases chips from manufacturers based in Taiwan.
- Trump said tariffs enacted on China during his administration have been effective and maintained during the Biden administration. He said they will be increased if he is elected.
- Trump criticized the Biden-Harris administration's handling of Russia's invasion of Ukraine and the expansion of conflicts in the Middle East. He said he would end these conflicts before taking office, if elected.
- Trump said Europe has not been contributing enough to the war in Ukraine and he would pressure European states to invest more in security.
- Trump said it is in the best interest of the United States for the war in Ukraine to end. He did not say if Ukraine should win the war.
